<p>When it comes to color, jewel tones like emerald green, ruby red, and sapphire blue tend to be universally flattering.</p> <p>While black is known for its slimming capabilities, you want to steer clear of dark colors when possible to avoid casting harsh, aging shadows on your face.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <i>Animated text: "When it comes to color"</i></li> <li>- <i>Display jewel tones</i></li> <li>- <i>Slide "Black" text in from right side of the screen</i></li> </ul>
<p>As for prints and patterns, remember that less is more, as they don't always translate well on camera. If you are going to wear a print, try pairing it with a solid sweater or jacket over it to reduce distractions.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <i>Insert prints and patterns animation with "Less Is More" text over it</i></li> <li>- <i>Slide "Solid Sweater or Jacket" text in from right side of the screen.</i></li> </ul>
